2010 National Show & Sale Wrap Up

The U.S. Targhee Sheep Association held its 2010 National Show and Sale in Wisconsin on July 15-17 at the University of Wisconsin – Madison Arlington Sheep Unit Public Events Center. The show and sale sponsored by the University of Wisconsin Animal Science Department and the Wisconsin Junior Targhee Sheep Association was co-chaired by Todd and Lynnette Taylor of Arlington, and Jeff and Leslie Nevens of Lodi.

The Targhee National Junior Show held July 16th was judged by Tim Miller, of Tailwind Rambouillets, Beloit, Wisconsin. Nineteen Targhee sheep were exhibited from seven states with young people traveling from as far away as Utah and Wyoming to participate. Every USTSA youth showman received a cash award sponsored by United Cooperative.

The National Junior Show Grand Champion Ram was shown by Andy Nevens of Lodi, Wisconsin while the Reserve Champion Ram was shown by Rory Lewis of Reed Point, Montana. Grand Champion Ewe honors also went to Rory Lewis, with the Reserve Champion Ewe shown by Ben Kukowski of Kaycee, Wyoming. Champion Senior Showman was Rory Lewis. Reserve Champion Senior Showman was Jamie Skinner of Felicity, Ohio. Champion Junior Showman was Andy Nevens of Lodi, Wisconsin, with Reserve Champion honors going to Braedon Hinker of Huron, South Dakota. A special Long Distance Award went to Brailie Allred of Fountain Green, Utah. To test their parents' showmanship skills, junior USTSA members took nominations to put adults into the ring for the Adult Jackpot Showmanship competition. Bridget Williams of Kaycee, Wyoming, won. A dozen adults competed and over \$150 was raised for the USTSA Junior Show program. All junior exhibitors were later treated to a tour of the Sassy Cow Creamery, located near Sun Prairie, Wisconsin.

National Open Show Judge, Larry Mrozinski with wife, Deb, former USTSA Secretary and Hall of Fame recipient. National Show & Sale continued . . .

The USTSA National Open Show followed the Junior Show. Judge, Larry Mrozinski, of San Pierre, Indiana, a nationally known livestock judge and long-time friend of the U.S. Targhee Sheep Association, named his Grand Champion, a ram shown by Dean and Charleen Von Krosigk of Riverton, Wyoming. It was purchased by Darrell Deneke of Brookings, South Dakota. McRae Brothers of Jordan, Montana, had the Reserve Champion Ram which sold to Warren and Judith Nellis of Coleman, Michigan. The National Champion Von Krosigk ram had high selling ram honors of \$2,200. The Reserve Champion McRae ram sold for \$1,800.

The National Champion Ewe was shown by Rory Lewis of Reed Point, Montana, and was purchased by Mark Pates of Volga, South Dakota, for \$500. The Reserve Champion Ewe was shown by Glenn and Joan High of Lexington, Ohio, with the sale going to Gordon Sammons of Geneseo, Illinois. The distinction of high selling ewe went to Glenn & Joan High with Mark Pates making the purchase for \$650.

National Sheep Improvement Program Champion honors went to the ram who was also the overall Reserve Champion Ram owned by McRae Brothers. Reserve Champion NSIP Ram was shown by A & J Nevens Livestock of Lodi, Wisconsin, and sold to Tom Boyer of Coalville, Utah. The National Champion NSIP Ewe shown by A & J Nevens Livestock was purchased by Jamie Skinner. Golden Willow Targhees of Kaycee, Wyoming exhibited the Reserve Champion NSIP Ewe and Logan Johnson of Huron, South Dakota made the purchase.

Golden Willows Targhees sold the Champion Pen of Two Yearling Ewes to Charles Dwight of Clyde, Ohio, for \$600 a piece. The University of Wisconsin's first place Fall Ewe

Lamb received a bid of \$500 from Bobby and Heidi Hood of Illinois, and the high-selling Spring Ewe Lamb consigned by Von Krosigk Family Targhees was purchased by Caleb Pederson of Lesterville, South Dakota for \$325.

On 54 head of registered Targhee sheep the sale average was \$426.39. Yearling rams averaged \$1,040.00 with National Sheep Improvement Program yearling rams averaging \$612.50. Yearling ewes averaged \$397.73 with National Sheep Improvement Program yearling ewes averaging \$300.00. Champion and Reserve Champion owners of sheep received from the Wisconsin Junior Targhee Sheep Association custom, hand painted saw blades depicting sheep scenes by Indiana artist Jane Chamberlin.

Mary Wallace of Cambridge, Wisconsin, a nationally recognized wool expert and the Superintendent of the Fleece Shows at the Wisconsin Sheep & Wool Festival, judged the USTSA National Wool Show. Champion and Reserve Champion ram fleeces were exhibited by A & J Nevens Livestock. Champion ewe fleece was exhibited by the University of Wisconsin –

Madison. Reserve Champion ewe fleece honors went to A & J Nevens Livestock. Overall Champion fleece went to University of Wisconsin-Madison with A& J Nevens Livestock receiving Reserve Champion placing.

As determined by a vote of the USTSA membership, the National Targhee Photo Contest awarded first place to Linda Poole of Malta, Montana, second place to A & J Nevens Livestock and third place to Linda Poole.

Receiving the annual designation of USTSA Premier Exhibitors, were A.J., Mary and Rodney Kuenzi of Waukesha, Wisconsin. The Junior Premier Exhibitor was 2009 USTSA Starter Flock Winner, Caleb Pedersen. Premier and Junior Premier Exhibitors were awarded USTSA traveling trophies for their efforts.

The Targhee Hall of Fame began honoring outstanding sheep men and women in 1983. Through this award, tremendous personal achievement along with contributions to the U.S. Targhee Sheep Association and American Sheep Industry are acknowledged. Continuing with a 27 year tradition, the 2010 Targhee Hall of Fame inductee was George Mann of Circle M Targhees in Fairchild, Wisconsin.

A new Targhee tradition started in 2009, with the awarding of the USTSA Starter Flock to a deserving youth (aged 9-17). The 2010 recipient was Jamie Skinner, son of John & Susie Skinner, from Felicity, Ohio. Jamie received a ewe lamb from Darrell Deneke; a yearling ewe from Von Krosigk Family Targhees; and a brood ewe from Warren and Judy Nellis. Jamie also received a buyer's credit totaling \$400 to purchase additional sheep from the Innes Ranch LLC – Robert Innes, Gillette, Wyoming (\$150); Montana Targhee
