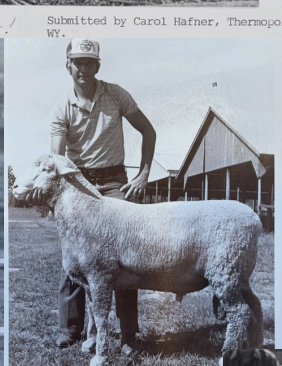
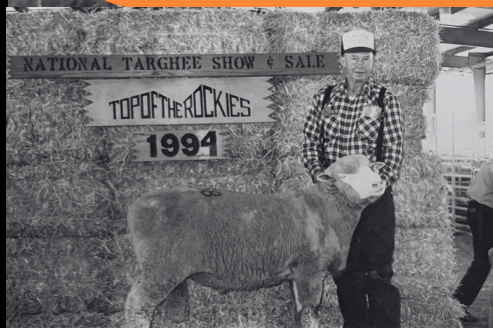

History of the Targhee

The western range industry has long demanded a breed of sheep, thick in natural fleshing, producing high quality apparel type wool, and adapted to rugged conditions. Such a breed would contribute to breeding stability and simplify marketing problems with uniform body type and fleece grade. Many sheep breeders thought the ideal range breed would be $\frac{3}{4}$ fine wool and $\frac{1}{4}$ long wool breeding. This was commonly called a “come back” sheep.

To fulfill this need the Targhee sheep was developed by the U.S. Sheep Experiment Station at Dubois, Idaho. In 1926 a group of 210 of the experiment station’s cross-bred ewes, consisting of Rambouillet, Lincoln, and Corriedale blood, were bred to nine of the smoothest, thickest experiment station Rambouillet rams. After three years of the program, 201 first generation ewes were carefully selected and bred intensely. These ewes weighed 91 pounds as yearlings after shearing. A wide range of variations were produced in the second and third generations, but careful selection reduced the variations in future generations.

The new breed of sheep was named Targhee after the Targhee National Forest where the sheep grazed during the summer.

The first private individual to breed Targhees was Henry J. Yoppe of Eureka, Montana. He began breeding $\frac{3}{4}$ crosses in 1929, and in 1934 bought his first Targhee ram from Dubois.

In 1942 Montana State University began a Targhee breeding program and over the next ten years a number of individuals began Targhee breeding programs. This was usually accomplished by sorting a band of Rambouillet, Columbia, or Rambouillet Columbia ewes that met the selection criteria for “Targhee Type” as established by the U.S. Sheep Experiment Station. In large bands this usually resulted in 10% or fewer being kept. Sieben Live Stock Company of Helena, Montana, sorted 12,000 Rambouillet ewes to come up with 800 that met the criteria. These ewes were then crossed with Targhee rams from Dubois. When the Targhee Association was formed it was determined that five generations of top crossing were required to register the sheep. On September 27, 1951 a group of top sheepmen met with the staff of the U.S. Sheep Experiment Station at Dubois and formed the U.S. Targhee Sheep Association. The first officers were: President, G. Curtis Hughes - Stanford, Montana; Vice President, Henry S. Hibbard – Helena, Montana; Directors, Henry J. Yoppe – then of Livingston, Montana; and Leo Pfister – Whitney, Nebraska. At a later meeting Steve Thompson – Heppner, Oregon was elected a Director and Bill Boylan – Bozeman, Montana was appointed Secretary/Treasurer.

In 1966, the books of the association were closed and since that time registered Targhees must be from registered parents. The states with large numbers of Targhees are Montana, South Dakota, Wisconsin, and Wyoming, but there are members in a total of 20 states as well as Canada.

- There is an additional charge to register any animal over two years of age.
- If return of Registration Certificate is required within 21 days of the date mailed, a "RUSH" fee of double the normal fee is charged. Write "RUSH" on the envelope and application
- Transfer fees, if recorded more than 45 days from the date of sale, are doubled.

The U.S. Targhee Sheep Association recommends inspection for registration take place at approximately 1 year of age.

2026 National Show and Sale Rules

1. All sheep consigned at the U.S. Targhee Sheep Association National Show and Sale, must be bred and owned by an Active Member of the U.S. Targhee Sheep Association that conforms to breed standards.
2. The Show/Sale Veterinarian will collect the CVI at the entry gate. A copy of the CVI is required for each animal and must accompany the animal in order to gain entrance. The inspector will retain the CVI. If the CVI does not accompany the animal(s), it (they) will not be unloaded.
3. Any question regarding the health of an animal will be based on the animal's condition as it is presented to the Show/Sale Veterinarian. This determination is at the discretion of the State Veterinarian or the official representative. Decision of the Veterinarian is final in regard to sifting.
4. Sheep exhibited at the USTSA National Show & Sale, as well as the flocks from which they come, must be free from contagious or communicable diseases such as Foot Rot or Club Lamb Fungus.
5. All rams shall possess two testicles and be fully intact. All yearling rams require a scrotal circumference measurement recorded on the CVI. The minimum requirement is 30 cm.
6. The USTSA requires all sheep must be dipped or sprayed for external parasites at least 10 and not more than 30 days prior to sale date. A statement must be furnished at check-in showing the date sprayed or dipped, the product used, the dilution rate for each sheep and a signature from the owner of the sheep. Only products labeled for use in/on sheep will be accepted.
7. Sheep must be registered prior to May 31, 2026.
8. All sheep entered shall have a breeder's flock tag and Scrapie tag in the left ear. If a registration tag was used, it must be in their right ear or a registration tag placed in a sealed envelope with the lot number stapled to their individual CVI. On the outside of the envelope, please write your name and the sheep's flock and registration numbers.
9. All yearling rams and ewes must have a side micron test taken and submitted for evaluation by a third party after May 1st of 2026 in order to show or sell at the National Targhee Show and Sale. Micron ranges from 26.39 (58's)-22.04 (64's). Sheep finer than 22.04 are acceptable with sufficient staple length.

Terms for the National Targhee Sale

1. Terms of this sale --- Check, cash or credit card (4% fee charged).
 2. All purchases are to be settled for on the day of sale at the sale office.
 3. Private sales of Targhee sheep before or during the auction are forbidden. The transaction of private sales, while sheep are still on the grounds, will be handled by the sale bookkeeper and the regular sale commission will be collected. Private sales of sheep are discouraged by the USTSA because of loss of revenue for consignors of the National Show & Sale.
 4. All sheep consigned to the sale are held at the Consignor's risk until sold. Ownership changes when the sheep are sold in the ring.
 5. Misunderstandings or disputes regarding bids will be settled by the auctioneer.
 6. Only bonafide bids will be accepted. Sellers have the right to bid once upon each lot offered.
 7. All bidding will be based on price per head – not on the pen as a whole.
 8. No sheep will be released except at the sale office and not until full payment at the sale office has been made.
 9. Transfer of registration certificates will be made at no cost to the buyer. Funds from the sale will be held by the Association Office until registration certificates and transfers are properly recorded in the Association books.
- GUARANTEE:** Every ram and ewe sold will be guaranteed by the breeder if properly handled. It shall be the responsibility of the buyer to return a non-breeder to the seller in acceptable condition. The seller, after a fair trial and the animal is found to be a non-breeder, shall have the privilege of replacing the ram or ewe with one of equal value to the satisfaction of the buyer, or refund the purchase price. This guarantee shall not apply to any sheep that are shown subsequent to the date of sale. Notification of a non-breeder ram and/or ewe must be made to the seller prior to July 1, 2027. This guarantee shall constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller only, and no other parties assume any liability, legal or otherwise, expressed or implied.

State Health Requirements for South Dakota

All livestock entering South Dakota must have an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) stating:

1. Name, address, and phone number of consignor; name and address of point of origin if different from consignor; name, physical address and phone number of consignee; name and physical address of destination if different from consignee information.
2. Species of animal, age, sex, breed, number, purpose of movement, test results, etc.
3. Signature, address and phone number of inspecting licensed accredited veterinarian. South Dakota Requirements SHEEP: Certificate Requirements: Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and permit number. The following statements **MUST** be true and appear on the CVI: a. "These animals are free from infectious, contagious diseases." b. "All animals are from non-quarantined flocks." Identification Requirements: All breeding animals (sexually intact animals at any age) must be officially identified. Official identification includes, Scrapie Identification tags, Official USDA RFID 840 tag (15 digit number) or a complete and legible breed registration tattoo. Individual Scrapie tags or flock numbers must be listed on the CVI. Testing Requirements Brucellosis: Rams 6 months of age and older, must be free of any gross lesions of ram epididymitis upon exam **AND MUST** be tested **NEGATIVE** for RAM EPIDIDYMITIS (BRUCELLA OVIS) by the ELISA test within 30 days prior to entry **OR** originate from a Brucella ovis free flock with a test record within the past year. Other Requirements: All rams must possess two testicles and be fully intact. Scrotal measurements may be taken during check-in, if not listed on CVI. All animals must be free of contagious disease and will be inspected on the premises by the Show/Sale Veterinarian.

National Sheep Improvement Program Rules

1. All NSIP rams and ewes are subject to the National Targhee Show & Sale rules and regulations. Rams and ewes shall be owned by the breeder and the breeder's flock must be enrolled in the National Sheep Improvement Program.
2. EPVs for the following traits must be posted by the breeder on the pens for each sheep enrolled in an NSIP class: 60 Day Weaning Wt, Maternal Milk Wt, Yearling Wt, Grease Fleece Wt, Fiber Diameter, Staple Length, and Number of Lamb Born. The wool micron on NSIP entries will also be posted on the pen and taken after May 1st.
3. Data for the required traits must be submitted for the **May 1st** run.
4. All rams and ewes must be shorn after **February 17th**.
5. A minimum of trimming will be allowed to clean up the sheep as long as it does not misrepresent the sheep or affect the natural character of the wool (eg. carding). No shearing of belly wool will be allowed after the animal's shearing date. Rams and ewes can be disqualified if the trimming misrepresents the sheep or wool (eg. wool blindness or level- ing of the topline).
6. In selecting the Champion NSIP ram and ewe, judging will be split 50/50 between the EPV records and the live show placing. Judging of the data will be done by the producers the morning of the show using the following point system. Every trait will be given equal rating and all animals ranked according to their EBV numbers with the "top" for each trait getting a 1 and the bottom getting the highest number. The individual rankings are tallied Placing (per class) Points Awarded: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 4 points, 3rd - 3 points, 4th - 2 points and 5th - 1 point. Overall Grand 5 points and Overall Reserve 4 Points and the lowest overall score is given a 1, second a 2 and so on. If there is a tie, both animals will receive the lower number.
7. For the selection of Grand and Reserve Ram and Ewe in the Championship Drive, the top two rams and ewes, in their respective classes, will automatically qualify for the Championship Drive. The NSIP numbers will have no impact on the live judging of the sheep. NSIP numbers and placings will go towards the Champion and Reserve NSIP Exhibitor for both ram and ewe.

Meet Your Judges

Our 2026 Junior Judge, **Tim Flint** resides in Viborg, South Dakota. Tim Flint of Viborg, South Dakota. Tim currently operates a commercial flock of 500 Dorset/Targhee ewes. He has extensive experience raising and exhibiting purebred Rambouillet and Corriedale sheep. Throughout his career, Tim has judged numerous national, FFA, and local junior sheep shows across South Dakota. Tim was also one of the top 10 sheep shearers in the nation during the 1980s and 1990s. In 1986, he earned the title of South Dakota State Champion Sheep Shearer. His shearing career provided opportunities to travel throughout the United States. During those years, Tim also purchased wool for the North Central Wool Company. One of Tim's lifelong passions is raising and training Border Collies. For more than 40 years, he has trained these dogs to work sheep and other livestock. Tim enjoys mentoring and teaching young people, recognizing that they are the future of the sheep industry.

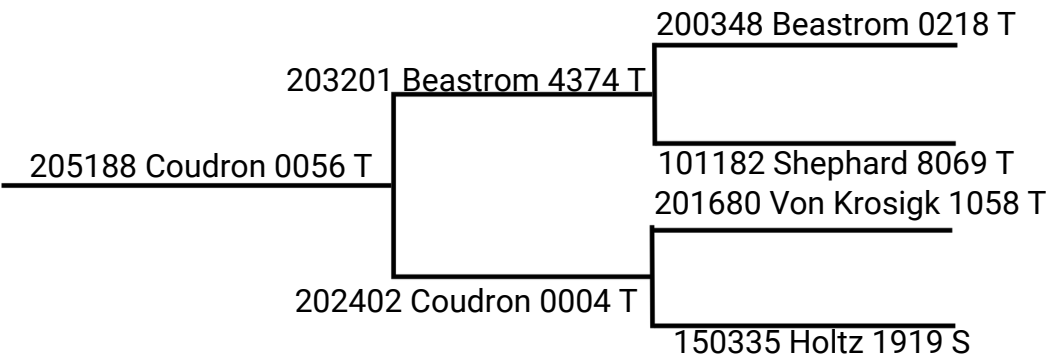

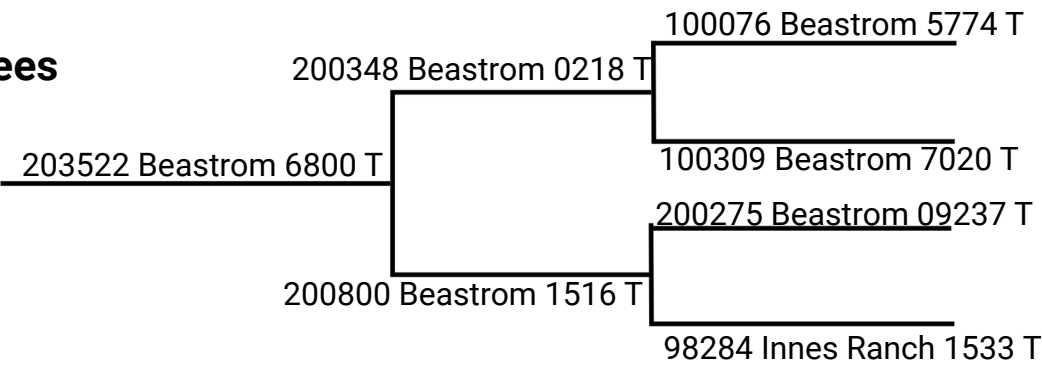

Quick Guide to EBV's

NLB The Number of Lambs Born (NLB) EBV (number) evaluates genetic potential for prolificacy. This EBV is expressed as numbers of lambs born per ewe lambing.

MWWT The Maternal Weaning Weight (MWWT) EBV (kg) estimates the genetic effects of the ewe on the weaning weight of her lambs. It can be thought of as a measure of the ewe's merit for mothering ability. This EBV mainly reflects genetic differences in ewe milk production, but other aspects of maternal behavior may also be involved

EMD The Loin Eye Muscle Depth (EMD) EBV (mm) is an indicator of genetic differences in muscling. Animals with positive Loin Eye Muscle Depth EBV are expected to produce offspring with larger loin eyes and are generally desirable

PWWT The Postweaning Weight (PWWT) EBV (kg) combines information on preweaning and postweaning growth to predict genetic merit for postweaning weight at 120 days.

YWT The Yearling Weight (YWT) EBV (kg) estimates growth potential to 12 months of age. Animals with high Yearling Weight EBV exhibit sustained postweaning growth, but ewe lambs with high Yearling Weight EBV are anticipated to have heavier adult body weights and greater maintenance requirements.

YFW The Fleece Weight (GFW) EBV (%) is based on greasy fleece weights and estimate the animal's genetic potential for wool production. . A GFW EBV of +10 thus indicates that the animal is expected to produce fleeces that are 10% heavier than average.

YFD The Fiber Diameter (FD) EBV (microns) estimates genetic merit for fleece quality. Animals with finer, more desirable fleeces have negative fiber diameter EBV, so negative EBV are favored for this trait.

YSL The Staple Length (SL) EBV (mm) estimates genetic potential for length of the wool fiber. Positive selection emphasis on Staple length EBV is recommended in flocks that receive premiums for long-staple fleeces or have experienced discounts for fleeces with excessively short staples

Range Index The US Western Range Index (%) was developed by NSIP to improve profitability in Targhee range flocks and is generally applicable to extensively managed Western range flocks with positive emphasis on both lamb and wool production. This index places major positive weight on early growth and ewe prolificacy and modest positive weight on increasing ewe maternal ability, increasing fleece weight, and reducing fiber diameter
