NSIP UPDATE BY CHASE T. HIBBARD

(The following report was submitted by Chase Hibbard, Helena, Montana. Chase is active on the ASI-NSIP committee and is actively enrolled in NSIP. Thank you, Chase, for the updated facts and progress with NSIP!)

The NSIP Executive Board met during the ASI convention in Reno and considered some exciting developments. The move from Iowa State to the American Polled Hereford Association (APHA) in Kansas City is now complete. Data turnaround is a priority and records will be processed at least once per week. A new user's manual has been completed and is available for distribution. It is well written and logically walks producers through the entire process. That is a great contribution. Discussions about adding an accelerated lambing trait, a cutability trait and making the program PC interactive for input and reporting of data are taking place.

The most exciting development is that the Executive Board has contracted with Dr. David Notter of Virginia Polytechnic Institute to do a "Connectedness" study and develop a system to begin producing EPDs across-flock. This is the next level of sophistication above the FEDPs now in use. What is even more exciting is that of all the breeds he searched, he settled with TARGHEES because of the large number of producers on NSIP who have used common animals among flocks. In addition, Targhee producers have used similar reporting dates for weigh periods and have consistently repeated fleece data. Some initial EPDs have been developed on TARGHEE fleece traits and they are very impressive.

Dr. Notter will continue to develop EPD methodology incorpo-

rating multiple-trait capability (NSIP is now single trait), and will refine the genetic correlation between traits and heritability estimates. When he has the TARGHEE data set, he will work on Polypays and Suffolks.

It is expected that Dr. Notter's work will be completed by fall and submitted to the APHA. When incorporated into the system, we will have moved into the next generation of sheep records with the ability to predict genetic value at the most advanced level. The breed association must then decide how to best use this powerful information. An exciting possibility would be to publish a sire summary for the breed similar to the major cattle breeds. Another possibility would be to move toward a performance pedigree for registered animals similar to what has been very successful in the swine industry.

It's gratifying to see that progress is finally being made in the timeliness of records processing, the rapidly approaching EPD across-flock capability and that TARGHEES are out in front of this important effort.
